



VILLAGE OF AKRON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

JUNE 16TH, 2026

The Village of Akron Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and roll call.

Council members present: R. Huizar, T. Nusz, M. Strasz, J. Carr, T. Tait

Motion by M. Strasz to approve May 19th, 2026, Council meeting minutes. J. Carr seconded the motion. All in favor 0 Nays 5 Yes. Motion passed.

Motion by T. Nusz to approve bills, obligations and payroll as presented, totaling \$27007.00. T. Tait seconded the motion. All in favor 0 Nays 5 Yes. Motion passed.

Police Report: Definitely staying busy. Chief Danielson has been working on getting the LEAN regulated correctly, trying to get the tokens needed to access everything. Chief Danielson and J. Holsapple will work on this together, the LEAN needs to be done, it has not been done since 2017. LEAN is used for running licenses and check to see if things are missing or outstanding. Chief Danielson has redone his EMR medical training. The park building was broken into again, the cameras were useful in helping us identify the person and that person was dealt with sufficiently.

Treasurers' Report: C. Wilson gave the council the monthly report and all the numbers match and look good. There will be a house going up for auction, the council was asked if they would like to purchase the property, the council unanimously denied the option to purchase said property. A waiver to deny the property needed to be approved.

Motion by T. Nusz to accept the waiver for the purchase of the property at 4334 Beach St. T. Tait seconded the motion. All in favor with 5 Yays and 0 Nays. Motion passed.

Presidents Report: Everything is going great; the employees just do their jobs with no hesitation. It was asked if the timeclock was necessary for the two employees that use it. T. Nusz asked if it was necessary for a workman's comp issue. C. Wilson will call MML and ask if will affect workman's comp by not using the time clock. A new swing was put in the park. A sandbox, volleyball set, and tether ball, were purchased by a couple generous residents for the park. A bench was also purchased for the strip of grass on N Main St in front of the bank. June 25th at the park is our 2nd annual Community Fun Day event, I hope everyone comes out and supports our village.

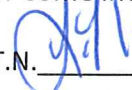
Public Works Report: S. Bills has been busy with mowing grass and brush cleanup. S. Bills finished the CCR (Consumer Confidence Report) it is posted at the hall. You can get a copy at the hall if you would like one. S. Bills repaired the damage at the park from the break in, he also repainted the posts and the parking lot lines at the village hall. S. Bills got three tree quotes for the removal of some trees at the park and on S. Main St., Kappen tree service came in the cheapest at \$5750.00. S. Bills also got a quote for the asphalt repair on N Main St and the spot located in front of the village hall. The cheapest quote was \$1600.00 for both locations.

Motion by: T. Nusz to have Kappen tree service remove the trees needed for \$5750.00, T. Tait seconded the motion. All in favor with 5 Yays and 0 Nays. Motion passed.

Motion by: T. Nusz to have Miller Seal repair the asphalt spots on N Main St and the spot in front of the Akron village hall for \$1600.00 M. Strasz seconded the motion. All in favor with 5 Yays and 0 Nays. Motion passed.

Fire Report: There were 6 fire runs this month. The firemen practiced tactics at the Judd Rd brush pile on May 20th. Both Engine 11 and Quint 12 passed their annual pump tests. Chief Hasso is working on grant submissions and fundraising activities for the department. Chief Hasso will also be applying for a DNR grant for radios which is 50/50 split in costs. The team has been doing some maintenance and small repairs on apparatus and equipment. Ther was a charging issue on Engine 11 that will probably require replacing the batteries. Also, the pump overheating alarm activated during one of the fires they were attending to. There was some concern over the tornado siren not going off in town, it was discussed and the Chief said that most people will get the alert on their phones before the firemen can even react. M. Strasz suggested applying for a grant for a new siren.

Clerk's Report: Summer newsletters went out, if you didn't receive one there are copies at the village hall. S.O.M.E. CPA is in the beginning stages of our yearly audit; they have received everything needed to complete the audit. BS&A has done their final extraction from my system and the go live date is June 29th for everything to be converted over to BS&A. Pay your bill online at bsaonline.com or come into the office and pay your bill with a credit or debit card.

Unfinished Business: Fun Day at the park June 25th from 5-8pm. Any help or volunteers would be appreciated. We are having a Foam Dance Party, Cornhole, Scavenger Hunt, Nerf War and many other games to play. Firetrucks will be there. Food trucks and a drink truck. It was decided by the council that the Ordinance for curb cutting would not be amended. The new cameras for the park will be installed, and we have a resident who will do the trenching for us at no cost to the village. The council also decided that the lines at the Ironhorse bar on the streets will remain as they are.

New Business: Concern over a dangerous building on N Main St was discussed and the owner has received two notices with no response. The building was discussed with the village attorney, and he suggested we hire a Inspector/Hearing Officer to inspect the building. There has been talk about sharing equipment with our neighboring village (Fairgrove). The council discussed the pros and cons of sharing equipment, and it was unanimously decided that the Village of Akron will not be sharing any of our equipment.

Motion by: M. Strasz to hire a building inspector/hearing officer to inspect the 3617 N Main St building, T. Nusz seconded the motion. All in favor with 5 Yays and 0 Nays. Motion passed.

Public Comment: None

Motion by: T. Nusz to adjourn the meeting at 6:52 pm, seconded by T. Tait. All in favor with 5 Yays and 0 Nays. Motion passed.
